# Grade

## Selection and specifications

The extra step in the grading process means our woods pass through a more stringent assessment. Grading is based on appearance characteristics, physical characteristics, sound defects, unsound defects and milling defects. The following is a list of what is taken into consideration when hardwood is graded:

### Appearance Characteristics

- 1) Color variation 2) Mixed grain 3) Drying checks 4) Reverse Grain 5) Birdseye 6) Pin knots 7) Water stain 8) Discoloration 9) Sticker marks 10) Molder knife marks

### Physical Characteristics

- 1) Bow 2) Crook 3) Cup 4) Twist

### Milling Defects

- 1) Skip 2) Torn grain 3) Non-compliant

### Sound Defects

- 1) Pin holes 2) Sound knots 3) Torn grain

### Unsound Defects

- 1) Large borer holes 2) Splits 3) Unsound knots 4) Shake 5) Sapwood

# Grade Notes

## Under Platinum Woods Products Grading Rules

Platinum Woods provides lumber that is kiln dried to have moisture content of 12-14% before milling, with a subgrade allowance of 5% to account for human error in the grading process

# Color

## & Grain Variation

As a natural product, wood will always exhibit color and grain variations between boards. This is part of the beauty that sets natural products apart from manufactured products. These variations are more pronounced in certain species, which should always be considered when choosing wood samples. A more uniform appearance can sometimes be achieved by either staining wood or allowing it to weather to a natural silver patina.

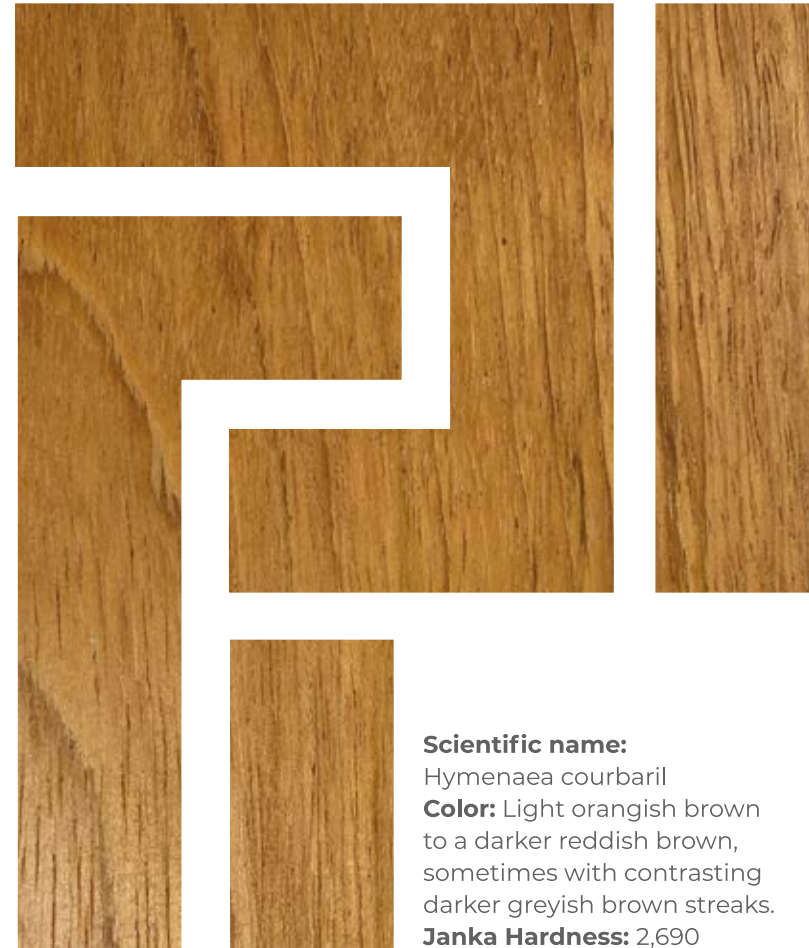

# JATOBA PLATINUM®

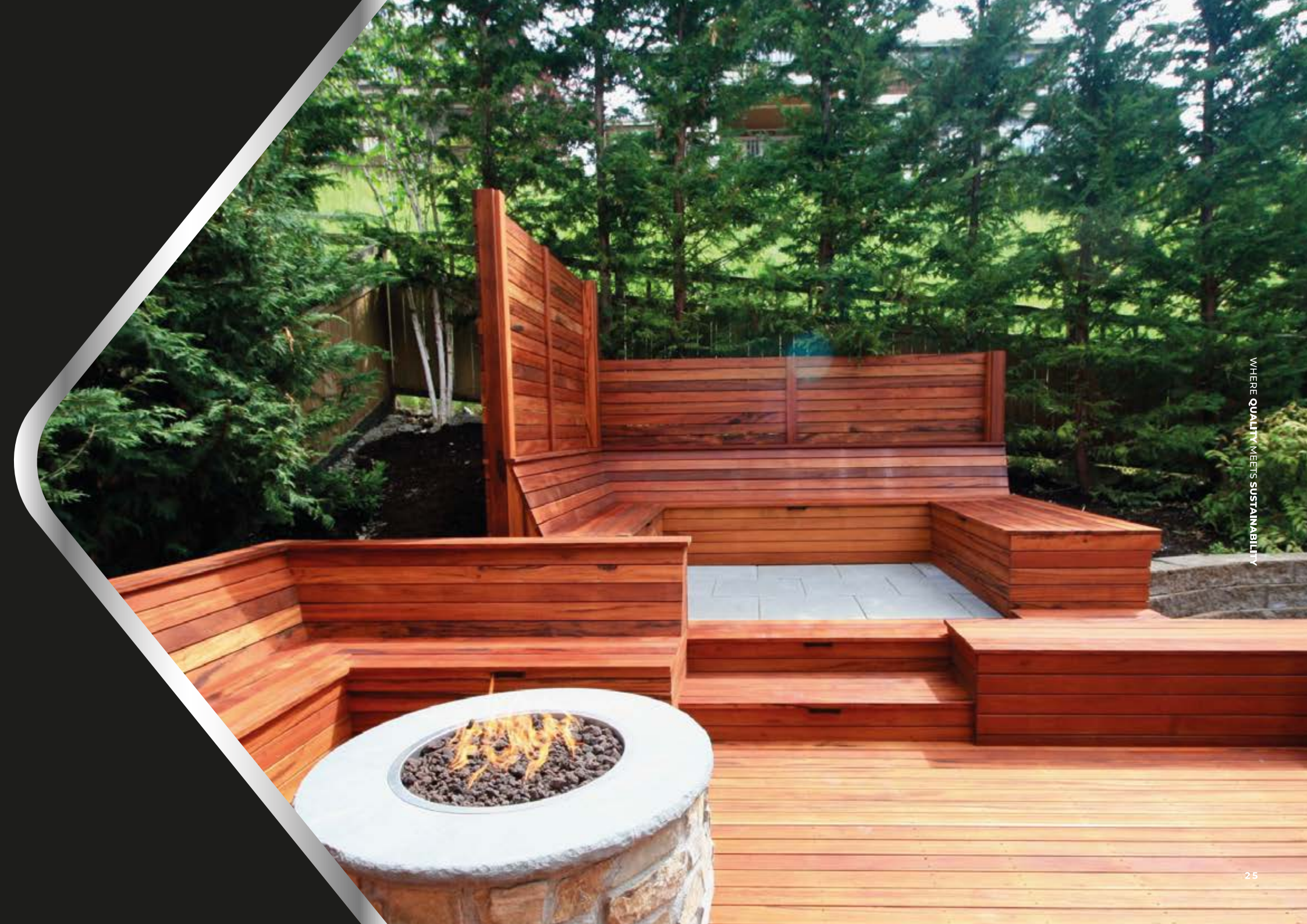


# TIGERWOOD PLATINUM®

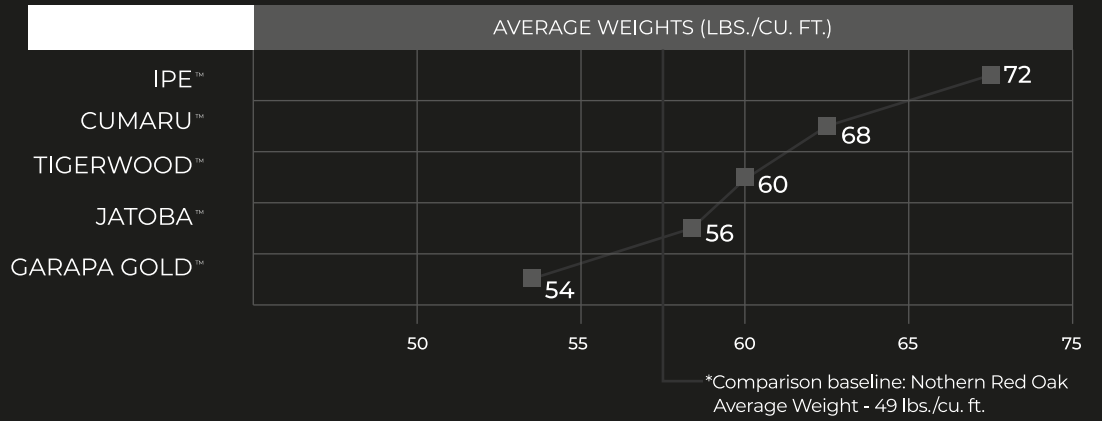
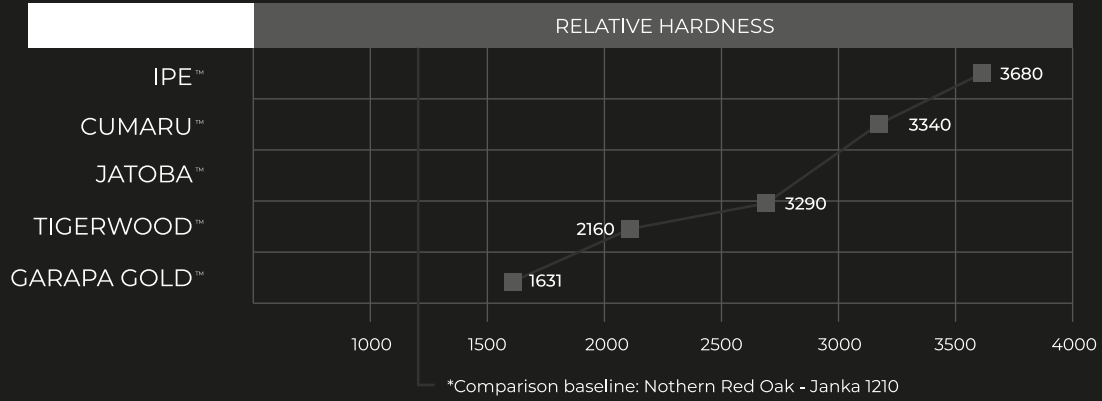
